

hours a day by a dedicated Security team

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
GETTING TO SOHO PLACE

- Tube: Tottenham Court Road (Elizabeth line, Central line, Northen line)
- Bus: Tottenham Court Road Stop V (routes at stop -55, 73, 98, 390, N8, N25, N55, N73, N98, N207)
- Train: Approximately 15-18 minutes walk from Charing Cross Station
- Parking: No (nearest car park Q-Park Soho)
- Drop off location: There is not a designated drop-off point - nearest convenient place is at Soho Square, or Charing Cross Road which is a minutes walk from the building

ENTRANCE/EXIT


- Entrance location: The entrance to 1 Soho Place is located on a pedestrian only street, accessed via Charing Cross Road or Sutton Row
- Wheelchair accessible: Yes, access pass door to the right of the main reception
- Entrance clearly marked: Yes, next to the main revolving doors on the right hand side
- Does the entrance door/area contract visually with its immediate surroundings: Yes, revolving doors have
 1 Soho Place' embossed on each unit with glazed access pass door to the right with contrasting signage
- Level access: Yes
- Intercom at entrance: Yes (Height 1.24m)
- Automatic doors: Fully automatic revolving doors
- Fully accessible automatic doors without access control:
 Automatic but with access control and intercom
- Doors open towards you: Yes (Width: 1.16 m)
- How to exit: Automatic / Wave to exit door release





RECEPTION

- Hearing loop induction: Yes
- Reception staff BSL trained: Yes
- Speed lane with increased width available: Yes (Width 1.11 m)
- Reception desk height: 1.01 m
- Water bowl for assistance dogs: Yes




LIFTS

- Dimensions, max weight & capacity of lifts:
 2.23m x 2.01 m, 1875kg max weight, 25 persons capacity
- What accessibility elements are in the lift: Main lifts are sized adequately to enable wheelchair users to be able to turn 180 degrees. Mirrors fitted in Goods & Firefighters lifts. Handrails in all lifts
- How are the lifts controlled: Access control. Building users will require an access pass provided by the on site security team
- Platform lifts at site in addition to passenger lifts: Yes, located between levels 9 & 10



STAIRS

- Number of steps between floors: 22
- Handrails available: Yes, they are on both sides through the length of the staircase. Handrails do not extend horizontally beyond the first and last steps



FACILITIES

- Accessible WC: Yes, on the ground floor within the reception area, and accessible bathrooms can be found on every floor
- Accessible shower & changing facilities: Yes, B1 level, within building's changing room entrance, accessed via the main lift lobby



OTHER

- Large print documentation available: No
- Braille documentation available: No
- Office floors are accessed via what kind of door: Manual operated door, pull to open with staffed Reception
- Is there a first aider on site: Yes
- Is there an evacuation chair in case of fire: The building benefits from Firefighter lifts and designation refuge points with communication to the 24 hour Security team. Tenants may elect to manage their own evacuation chair
