The Group maintains a suite of policies and procedures to ensure that it complies with all current legislation relating to Health and Safety. They are reviewed annually as a minimum in order to capture any new legislation or legislative changes and to ensure they are continually improved. The Group directly employs a chartered Health and Safety professional as its Head of Health and Safety to assist in managing compliance with its obligations and responsibilities.

Every employee is required to co-operate with the Group to enable all statutory duties to be complied with. The successful implementation of this policy requires total commitment from all employees. Each individual has a legal obligation to take reasonable care for his or her own Health and Safety and for the safety of other people who may be affected by his or her acts or omissions.

This policy is an integral part of our core business strategy and as such is reviewed annually by the Executive Committee and updated as necessary.
